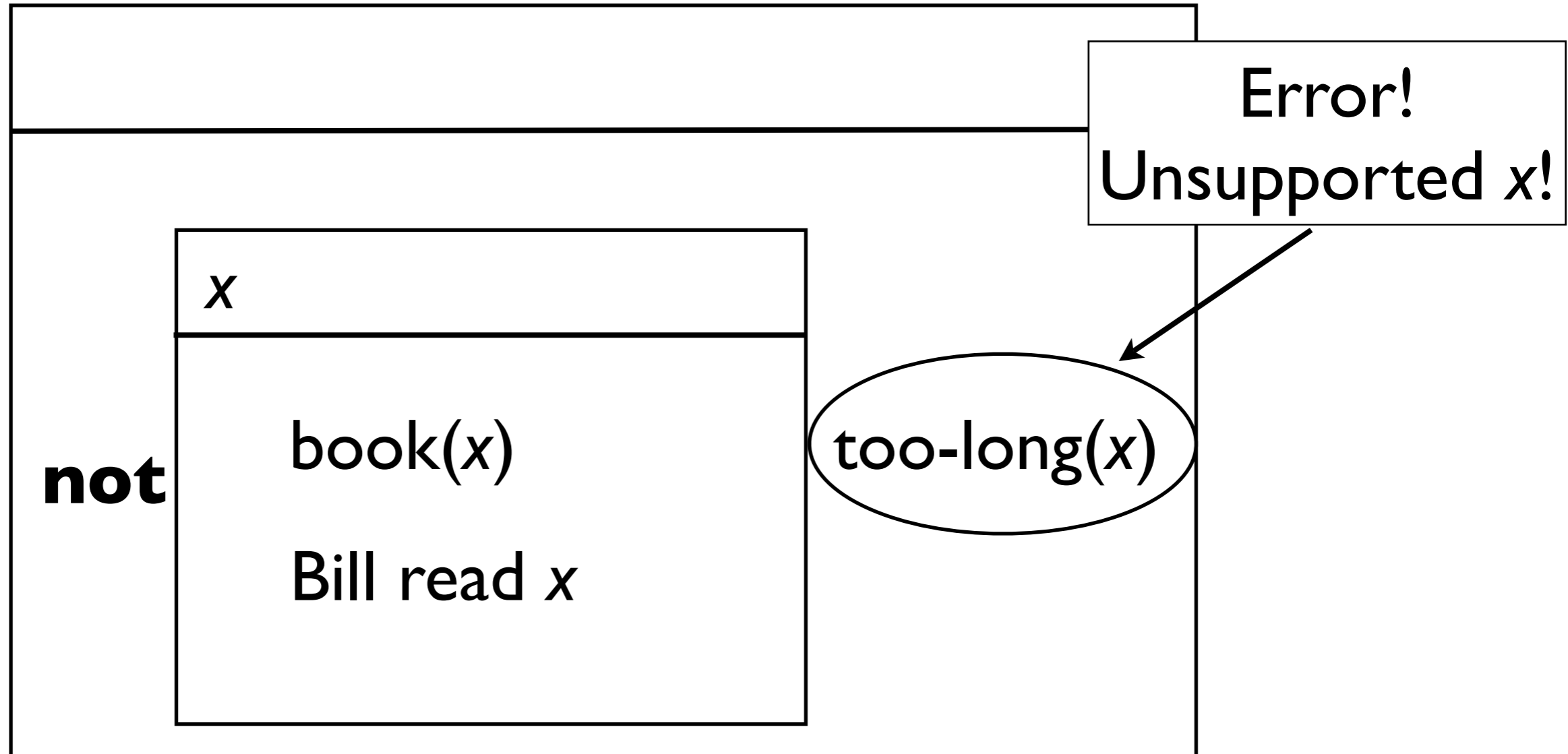

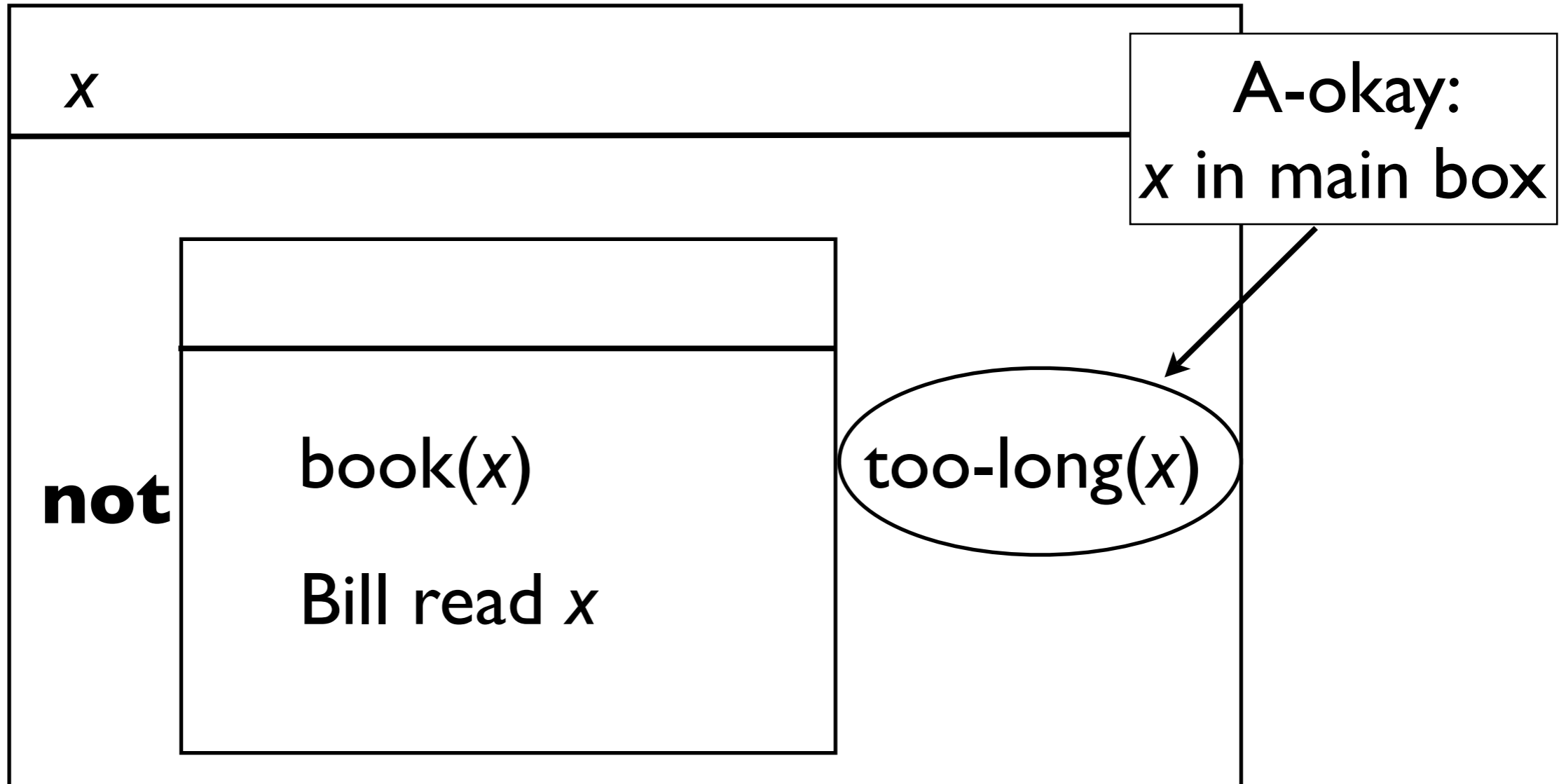
Bill didn't read a book. It was too long.

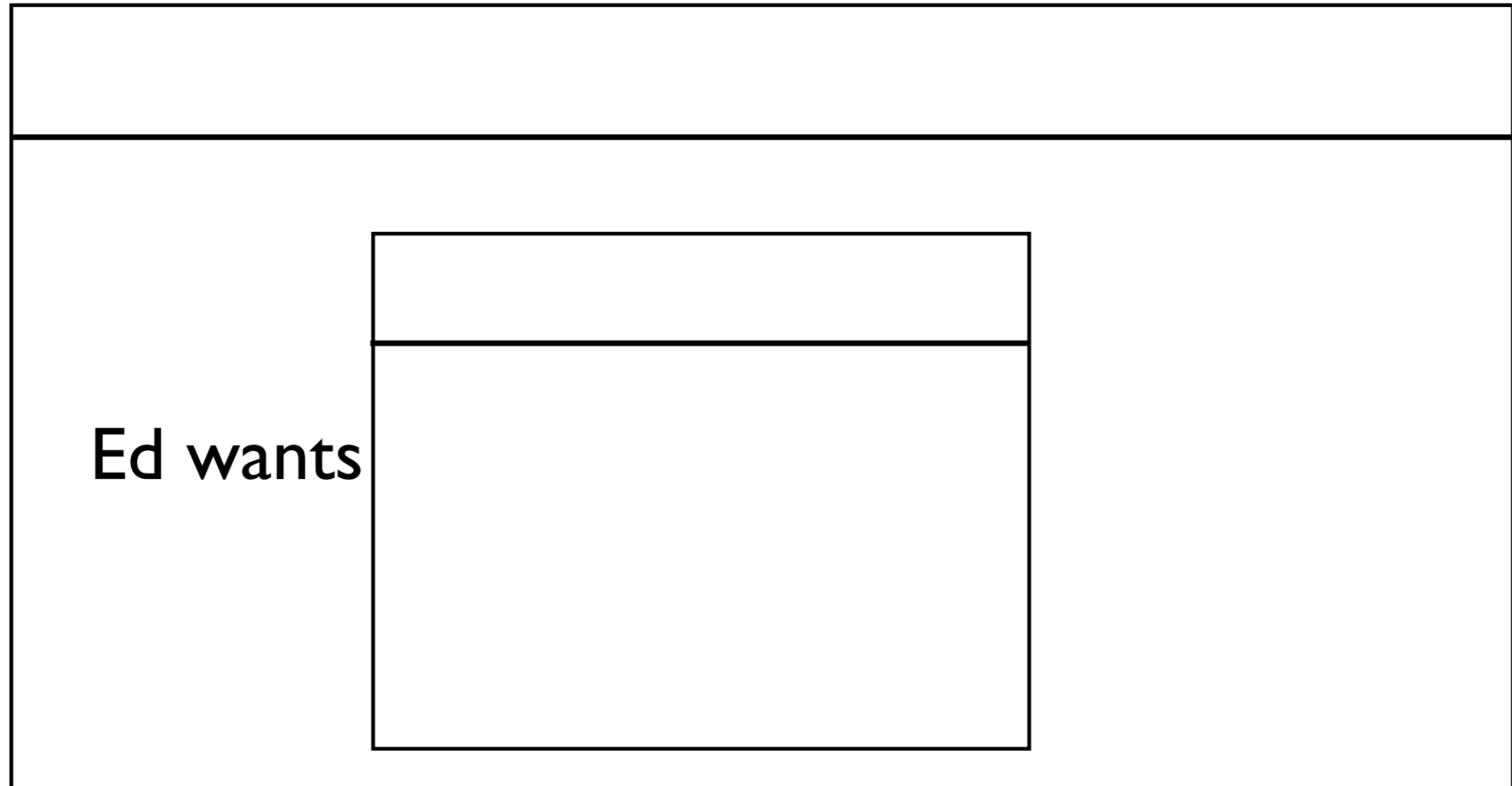
